Description: Small volume with cream-colored carboard binding. The album

contains two books bound together with 109 and 220 botanical woodcut-illustrations each. Both books were written by Rembert Dodoens, and published by Christophe Plantin. The first book "Florum" contains woodcuts by Arnaud Nicolai and Geeraard Jansen van Kampen, after drawings by Petrus van der Borcht. It is the second edition of the book, printed in 1569, as is also evident from the inscription on the title-page: "Altero edition". Many of the plates are touched with one or two

simple colors, such as red, green, yellow and purple.

The second book "Purgantium" was published in 1574. This book is undescribed in *Hollstein*, but since the style and executing of the woodcuts relate closely to those of "Florum", it is plausible that the same artists were involved in its

production.

#### **CREATION:**

This volume is part of the Fondo Corsini of the Biblioteca dell'Accademia nazionale dei Lincei e Corsiniana. The Fondo Corsini or Biblioteca Corsiniana is the oldest and most important section of the library, containing the collection of Cardinal Neri Corsini (1805-1859), which holds publications by early members of the Academy alongside rare manuscripts, incunabula and printed books from the sixteenth to eighteenth century.
