Description: Album with 71 bound prints, of which some are folded to fit the album. Only those in which Dutch or Flemish producers were involved are catalogued here. Some sheets bear the watermark of J. Hoonig & Zoon suggesting the paper was produced in Zaandijk in the 18th century. Quarter vellum binding with blue paper sides, of which the spine is decorated with blind stamped gilded ornaments. The spine is numbered 88 and holds the title: "P. BERETTINI OPERE DIVERSE VOL. I.". Another numbering on the spine reads "0. II. 33".
