Part one is entitled 'Series chronologica et imagines regum hispaneæ ab Ataulpho ad Carolum II. feliciter regnantem' and contains 28 prints, of which one frontispiece, all engraved by Jacques Blondeau. Each of the 27 portrait plates consists of 3 portraits in medallions with Latin captions in cartouches underneath, individually number 1 to 81. The format of the border decorations including medallions and cartouches appears in six different variants. Each print is cut out along the edges and pasted on the album's blank pages. The series is followed by five more portraits of later kings following the same format, but by an unknown engraver.

Part two is entitled 'Effigies et series regum Hispaniæ' and contains a frontispiece and 37 prints with portraits of Spanish kings in medallions with Latin captions in cartouches underneath.

The volume has a leather binding with the coat of arms of Cardinal Girolamo Casanata and marbled boards.
