CREATION:

This volume is part of the Fondo Corsini of the Biblioteca dell'Accademia nazionale dei Lincei e Corsiniana. The Fondo Corsini or Biblioteca Corsiniana is the oldest and most important section of the library, containing the collection of Cardinal Neri Corsini (1805-1859), which holds publications by early members of the Academy alongside rare manuscripts, incunabula and printed books from the sixteenth to eighteenth century.

This particular volume is interesting because it contains two books produced by the same publisher, bound together. The record in the inventory only refers to the first book: "Struys (Jean) Les voyages ... en Italie, en Grèce, en Moscovie ..., 1681, Amsterdam". The second book is "Relation du Naufrage" written by Frans Jansz van der Heiden. Both books were published by Annetje Philips Goulet in 1681 in Amsterdam.
